You are invited to attend the 2014 Carrot Cultivar Field Day!

The field day is primarily focused on carrots. The field day will begin with a brief presentation on a national scope project aimed at evaluating the differences in cultivar performance in organic and conventional carrot fields. Carrots from that project will be on display from 9 am to noon to view at your convenience and to discuss with Dr. Simon.

Additionally, a plot tour will be conducted at 10:30 to view other research being conducted by WSU Extension at the Research Farm on Road 80. Research plots that can be viewed on the tours include: spider mite control of sweet corn, fungicide seed treatments on sweet corn, plant population studies on sweet corn, insect control on potatoes, and onion thrips control on onions.

Researchers present to discuss their research will include: Dr. Phil Simon, USDA ARS Carrot Breeder; Dr. Lindsey DuToit, WSU Plant Pathologist; Dr. Carrie Wohleb, WSU Regional Vegetable Specialist; and Dr. Tim Waters, WSU Regional Vegetable Specialist.
